

- Wish us all a fruitful exchange related to EDU4Standards!









Impacts

- Impact #1: Higher visibility of standardisation knowledge in curricula and courses by 11 HEI with standards teaching teamed up with 100 other HEI supported by CEN
- Impact #2: >200 teachers having standardisation knowledge by the end of the project, CWA provides further support.
- Impact #3: More students gaining standardization knowledge short/medium term: >200 students and professionals are educated by the pilots, long term: Europe's industry has additional 5,000 standards experts p. a. by 2027 (50 in 100 HEI).
- Impact #4: More standardisation knowledge available for new teaching content attracting more students details based on KPI table: >#200 courses, #5 modules on standards and green transitions, # 5 modules on standards and digital transition, CWA
