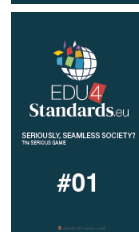
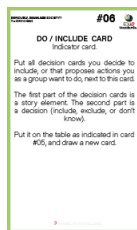
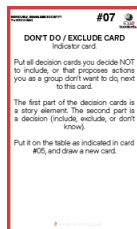
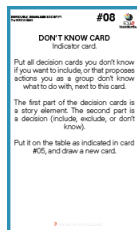
These are indicator cards. Place them as indicated. Further instructions are on the cards.

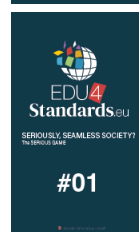
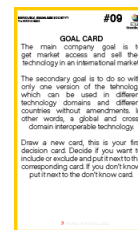
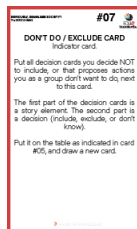
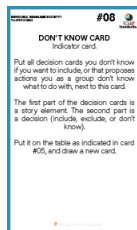
Then, draw another card, the goal card, and place as indicated on the table.
