## Summer School on Standardisation

Things determine how we live.

To be able to help shape the design of things, knowledge of standardisation is required. This knowledge will be imparted in the summer school to three groups: Teachers, Researchers, and Technology Transfer Professionals.

## **Programme**

The **summer school** on standardisation begins in mid-September with a basic module for all participants. The summer school starts on **Monday, September 15**, with an informal get-together where all participants can get to know each other and exchange ideas on **standardisation** and **EU values and interests (Stand-EUVI)** 

On Tuesday, September 16, participants will work with trainers from academia and standardisation institutions to acquire basic knowledge of "**Stand-EUVI**", which will be integrated into their own work environment in the afternoon.

In all three slots, concepts will be developed that could later be rolled out sustainably.







Importantly, this summer school is a pilot project of the Horizon Europe project EDU4Standards.eu; participation is free of charge.
